

## The Nuffield Trust For The Forces of The Crown

The Nuffield Trust finances recreational and welfare amenities and facilities that will benefit those serving in the British Armed Forces, but which are not provided by public funds and beyond the resources of other non-public funds. In this context, the "Armed Forces" does not include Ex-Service men or women or Cadet Forces, but does include active Reservists.

To mark the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Trust in 1999, a special grant of £1.35 Million was made to provide the Nuffield Centre, a facility that jointly benefits the Royal Navy, the Army and the Royal Air Force through the provision of Family and Dormitory accommodation. The facility now includes a campsite, climbing wall and Sailing and Watersports Centre.



Access to the Nuffield Centre could not be easier, with the North Wales A55 Expressway only a minute away and Bangor Railway Station a short taxi ride.

The Nuffield Centre is unrivalled as a base for exploring the coast and mountains of North Wales. With numerous outdoor adrenalin filled activities to take part in, as well as countless attractions and activities for families - the Nuffield Centre provides an affordable and welcoming base to access the best that North Wales has to offer.



## Welcome to Anglesey

Mountain walks, beaches, climbing, historical buildings and landmarks, open countryside, coastal paths, sailing and watersports - just some of what Anglesey and the surrounding North Wales area has to offer.

Located within a stone's throw of all of this and more is the Nuffield Centre, a Tri-Service recreational centre located in the village of Llanfair PG, Anglesey, overlooking the Menai Strait.

The Centre is open to all British Service personnel and their families to use as a holiday centre and for Service personnel to use as a base for adventurous training in Snowdonia and the surrounding coastline.



## Nuffield Accommodation

The family accommodation consists of nine rooms of varying sizes over two floors, each with a Freeview TV and an en-suite shower room and toilet. Bedding is included. There are two fully equipped self-catering kitchen diners. The upstairs diner is located with the lounge providing sofas, a large screen TV, Freeview and DVD player.

The dormitory style accommodation offers units or groups up to 50 beds in four to eight person rooms. There are separate male and female ablutions over the two floors, together with a large meeting/lounge area with a small kitchenette to prepare hot drinks. An adjacent kit and boot room provides plenty of lockable storage for kit. Personnel will require their own sleeping bag and pillow case. On duty personnel can book feeding in the JSMTTC Cookhouse.

Both wings have access to the laundry room offering two free to use washing machines and a drying room.

## Nuffield Sailing & Watersports Centre


The Nuffield Sailing & Watersports Centre is set directly on the banks of the Menai Strait. It is an RYA recognised and ASA affiliated Training Centre running dinghy, powerboat and theory based courses, together with sailing taster sessions. The Centre also offers taster sessions in Stand-Up Paddle Boarding and Sit-On Kayaking. Facilities include showers, toilets, bar, kitchenette and a large balconied lounge come classroom directly overlooking the Menai Strait and outdoor BBQ area where families and groups can hire the Centre's charcoal BBQ. The Centre is an ideal location for meetings and can be hired separately.

## Campsite

Our Campsite is adjacent to the Sailing & Watersports Centre. The site has been landscaped into eight large alcoves, sheltered and surrounded by trees and shrubs. Campsite guests are given use of the showers and toilets within the Sailing & Watersports Centre, where there is also a small outside sink for washing up and they are welcome to use the laundry and drying room in the main accommodation block.

## Climbing Wall

The Indy Climbing Wall offers beginners and experts alike facilities one expects from a modern indoor climbing wall - climbing and bouldering walls, family taster sessions, a cafe, a shop and a friendly, relaxed atmosphere.



## Joint Service Mountain Training Centre - Indefatigable

The Nuffield Centre sits within the grounds of JSMTTC HQ - known as Indefatigable following the site's use as a Merchant Navy School from 1944 - 1995. Later purchased by the MOD, the site was re-opened in 1999 as the HQ for JSMTTC. The buildings and grounds have fabulous views of the Menai Strait with a panoramic view of the Snowdonia Mountain Range and are within minutes of the Snowdonia National Park and yards from the Anglesey Coastal Path.
